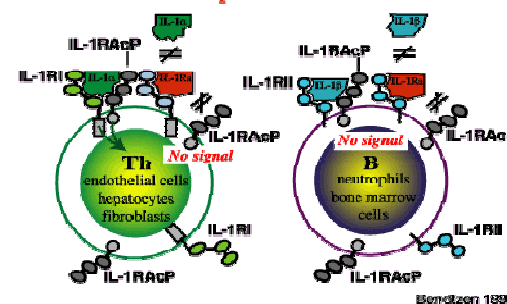

The Teaching Platform will be focused on the understanding of immune function from innate to cytokine responses in both infections and inflammatory conditions. The cytokine responses from T-cell subsets (Th1/Th2), physiopathologic response to endotoxins and the immunotherapy targeting on cytokines. The round table discussion sessions on cytokine response in Dengue's haemorrhagic fever (DHF) and HIV highly exposed seronegative (HEPS) person will provide the opportunity for all participants to exchange the ideas. The practical class will offer participants with technical experience on the detection/titration of cytokines using the methods of competitive RT-PCR and ELISA.
